Wednesday, July 16: 9a.m. travel from San Carlos to Mt. Graham. Set up camp and build Sweat Lodge for the evening sweat

<u>Thursday</u>, <u>July 17:</u> In the morning, Holy ground prayers and 32 songs/blessing the staff, then hiking to the top of Mt. Graham (Dzil Nchaa Sian) to gather stones and retrieving the holy water

<u>Friday</u>, <u>July 18:</u> Mt. Graham Sacred Run 2014 starts at 5 a.m. in the morning from the Top of Mt. Graham to San Carlos then to Oak Flats. Should reach Oak Flat by evening.

<u>Saturday</u>, <u>July 19:</u> 8 a.m. Morning blessing done by Mt. Graham Sacred Runners. Lunch at noon. Speakers from 2-4 p.m. Church service by Emmanuel Baptist Church Rev. John Mendez of Winston Salem, NC. 7:30 p.m. Apache Social Songs.

Sunday, July 20: 7:30 a.m. Breakfast—-8:30 a.m. Holy Ground Blessing. Everyone Departs.
